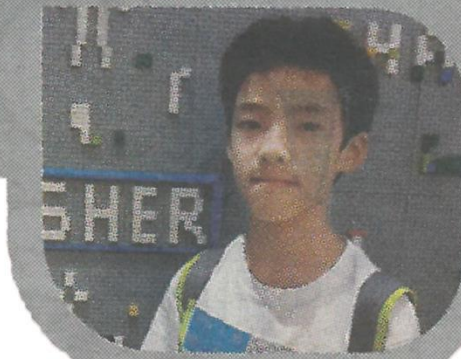


**Asher Lau Ka-yan, 14,
